PUBLIC NOTICE TO BOIL WATER FOR CITY OF BYNUM

Due to a loss of pressure of our water supplier Brandon Irene WSC the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required the City of Bynum to notify all customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you.
