## PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING WATER USE FOR THE CITY OF BYNUM BOIL WATER NOTICE

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requires the City of Bynum to notify all customers when a boil water notice is issued. As of 08/31/2024 water from the City of Bynum was notified that Brandon-Irene is under a Boil water notice. To ensure the deconstruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source. When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the boil water notice has ceased by post on two doors to the City Hall, The outside shadow box at the City Hall on White Ave. and at the post office board.
